These terms & conditions govern your participation in the Event. By registering for and or participating in the Event, you agree to these terms and conditions.

- 1. "We", "us", "our" or "Quadient" refers to the entity within the Quadient Group hosting the Event. Quadient Group refers to Quadient S.A. and any direct or indirect subsidiary of it.
